ADDITIONAL LETTER FOR KEY WORKER PARENTS/CARERS

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to let you know the arrangements for the childcare provision we are offering from Monday 23rd March. These will be as follows:

- Your child should come to school in comfortable clothes and ideally wear trainers. They should bring in a suitable coat and you may also wish to send in wellies as we may on some days offer Forest School type activities.
- Your child should bring in a water bottle as usual
- If you usually pay for school dinners or your child receives free school meals, these will be provided by our school kitchen as usual. Otherwise you should send your child in with a packed lunch. If your child usually has a packed lunch but during this time you would prefer to switch to school dinners, please let us know.
- Your child should bring in their work pack that has been sent home tonight; we will work through these each morning. In the afternoons, we will plan fun, creative and/or outdoor activities.
- At least 5 members of school staff will be in each day and we will split the children into a KS2 group and a KS1 and Reception group.
- Children will have morning break and a lunch-time break as normal on the yard
- School will open at 8.45am and you should bring them to the main office. We will be starting each day with a Jo Wicks workout in the hall!
- School will close at 3.30pm and you should collect your child from the main office.

We will continue to follow government advice and guidelines and review the provision each week. Next Thursday, we will ask you to let us know if you require the same days for the following week.

Please continue to carefully follow government guidance about self-isolation. If your child develops a new continuous cough and/or a fever, you should not send them into school and follow the self-isolation guidelines. We will contact you immediately should your child display any of these symptoms while in school.

I'm sure your child will really enjoy their days with us as usual. Please contact us if you have any further questions. Take care and we will work together to support our communities in these difficult and uncertain times.
