Dear Parent/Carer,

I do need to inform you that we have reached capacity in the majority of our classes for children of Key Workers. Please do still get in touch if a need for a place arises during the next few weeks however and we will do what we can to support you.

The class Zoom meetings have been going well this week and it has been lovely for teachers to chat with pupils working from home. There will be no Class Zoom meetings on Mondays or Fridays and instead I will send out a Rights Respecting Schools Assembly video on Mondays and a Golden Assembly video on Fridays via Class Dojo. Children in school will watch these videos in their classes.

I will send a newsletter out at the end of next week with news from home and school. In the meantime, please look after yourselves and as always get in touch if we can support in any way.
