Year 6 Parent/Carer Spectators

As it will be their last Sports Day at Ouston Primary, we will arrange for parent spectators to join us for the Year 5/6 Sports Day. In order to stay in line with restrictions however, we will have to limit this to one adult per child. This means we can have two groups of less than 30 for each class. These groups will need to remain separate and we will direct you to the spectator area for your child's class and ask you to leave at separate times at the end of the event.

If you wish to attend, please let us know the name of the parent attending either by Class Dojo or by ringing the school office. You will then be given a ticket. Only parents/carers with a ticket will be able to attend the event. As with the other Sports Days, we will also add lots of photos and videos to Class Dojo in Years 5 and 6 to ensure that parents/carers who are not able to attend can see their child participate in these.

I'm sure your child will really enjoy their Sports Day and hopefully next year we can get back to our usual organisation. In the meantime, I'm sure you can appreciate that we need to follow the guidelines and continue to observe social distancing rules to keep everyone safe and to avoid having to close year group bubbles in the last few weeks of the term.
