Class Dojo

As you are aware, we use a free app called Class Dojo as an additional way to communicate with parents/carers/families and to share some of the wonderful things that go on in our classrooms each week.

We would love it if all parents/carers sign up to Class Dojo and your child's class teacher will give you instructions about how to do this if you are not already signed up. Please ask us for help if you have any difficulties. Once you are signed up, your child's Class Teacher will use Class Dojo to communicate with you in the following ways:

- Send photos and/or messages related to whole class activities/learning (usually at least once a week)
- Send individual messages occasionally about something special your child has achieved
- Send messages/reminders to parents/carers.
- It is also a useful way for the teachers to set some homework tasks for children.

Class Dojo should not be used as a way for parents/carers to contact teachers however. The following forms of communication are available to you for this:

- Email the teacher using info@oustonprimary.org.uk. Please add into the subject box 'FAO Mr/Mrs/Miss...' so the office can direct this to the relevant teacher. The teacher can then either send an email reply or will contact you by telephone
- Phone the school office or pop in to ask for a message to be passed on to the Class Teacher or to request a meeting or phone call
- For more urgent issues, contact the school office and ask to speak to me or Mrs Wise
- Please inform us about absences, appointments etc through telephoning the school office.



The reason we don't use Class Dojo for parent/carer communication is that this can lead to teachers reading and answering lots of messages (often quite lengthy) out of school hours; this can encroach on their planning and marking time in addition to time with their own families and does not allow them to switch off from work.

Teachers will from time to time send messages directly to individual parents/carers – for example if organising after school activities/sports events etc and you can of course reply to these as needed.

Many thanks for your support with this and do let us know if you experience any difficulty when using the methods of communication described above.
