

This was a lovely day when children found out more about this event in history and then enjoyed a range of outdoor games, music from the 1940s and some celebration sweet treats!

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
















A New Arrival for Miss Lowery!

This will take place during week beginning 7th July and we have a number of activities planned. We would also welcome any parents/carers who would be happy to come into school and talk to their

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












child's class about their job/career. Please either get in touch with your child's Class Teacher via Class Dojo or contact the school office if you would like to be involved.
